IF AN ANGLER HAS ANY PHYSICAL LIMITATION/IMPAIRMENT/NEED PLEASE EXPLAIN ON BACK OF FORM
It is of the utmost importance that the team understand that boater is at least 18 years old prior to the event date, and failure to do so means that the team WILL NOT compete in that tournament. The boater must have and provide a copy of \$100,000 liability insurance. If you have any questions contact the Tournament Director.

Tournament Fishing Rules

1. In the event of inclement weather prior to the start of a seminar, all decisions will be made at the ramp by the tournament director or by an appointed seminar committee member. After the start of a tournament, the decision will be at the discretion of the team participating. However, if one member of the team wants to leave the water the other member must comply or risk disqualification. If the team trailers the boat and the weather improves, they may return to complete the seminar without penalty if time remains.
2. Both partners must remain in the boat at all times except in cases of dire emergency or where their safety is involved. Fishing only "from within the boat" is permitted.
3. All boats will be started in an "ooze-off" manner away from all coves, marinas and boat ramps. The seminar committee will determine the starting order. The highest number boat drawn prior to the seminar will start each boat for the seminar.
4. Fishing is permitted any place on the seminar waters unless posted as NO FISHING. NO fishing is permitted within 50 yards of another member's boat that was first in that location, unless given permission by the partners in the first boat.
5. Any fishing boat may be used that is 15 feet or more in length. Any motor may be used that does not exceed the horsepower capacity plate on the boat. A smaller additional gasoline or electric motor may be used to maneuver the boat while fishing. TROLLING IS NOT ALLOWED.
6. Only artificial bait or lures may be used. LIVE BAIT MAY NOT AND WILL NOT BE USED.
7. Each team must present fish to a measuring official to be measured. Once measured, official will mark length and time. Team will sign the score sheet.
8. All boats must comply with U.S. Coast Guard safety regulations. All contestants are required to have PFD's (life jackets) on and properly secured anytime the combustion engine is in operation.
9. All State and Federal boating and fishing rules will be observed at all times.
10. All boats having remote controls and used in a tournament must have a "KILL" switch in operating order. The kill switch will be connected to the boat operator when the boat is on plane.
11. Periodic boat inspections will be held at the discretion of the tournament director.
12. All boats used in this tournament must be insured and proof of insurance must be turned into the seminar director prior the start of the seminar before the boat will be permitted for use in the event.
Boat owners must carry a minimum of \$100,000 single limit liability insurance.

Tournament Fishing Prizes

Prize distribution will be dependent of number of teams.
There will be 6 Academy Gift Cards presented to hourly big fish winners.
There will be on grand prize winner of an Academy Gift Card.
Ties will be broken by earliest time weighed.
Gift card distribution will be 10% hourly and 40% overall, all presented at conclusion of event.

SSG Waiver and Release (Youth)

As a condition of me being permitted to participate as an angler or boater in this local event, an opportunity available to a limited number of people, and for other goods and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged and intended to be legally binding, I agree to the following:

Name and Likeness Release: I hereby grant permission to the Sunflower State Games, its parent companies, its subsidiaries and subsidiaries of its parent and their affiliates, their successors, licensees and assigns (the "Distributors") to utilize my appearance, performance, name, voice and likeness in connection with the Event itself and any productions incorporating or based on the Event, in connection with publicity for the Event and future editions of the Event and in connection with the promotion, and any tournaments or other events staged by the SSG in any and all manner and media throughout the universe in perpetuity. I hereby waive any rights that I may have to inspect or approve finished product or any advertising copy that may be used in connection therewith or the use to which it is applied. I hereby warrant that I have the right to make this release and that my granting this release and the rights conveyed thereby will not infringe the rights of any third party.

Physical Condition: I am physically fit to participate in the Event, and have not been advised otherwise by a medical practitioner.

Equipment and Facilities Inspection: I agree that before I participate in the Event, I will inspect the related facilities and equipment. I will immediately advise the supervisor of the Event of any unsafe condition that I observe. I will refuse to participate in the Event until all unsafe conditions observed by me have been remedied.

Assumption of Risk: I understand that I and each participant in the Event will be engaging in activities that involve the risk of serious personal injury, illness, permanent disability, dismemberment and death, and that also involve the risk of severe economic and property loss and damage. I understand that these risks may result from the actions, negligence, fault, omission and failure to act of myself and others (including but not limited to the Event Host Cities and other participants in, and the sponsors, organizers, and volunteers of the Event) and from the rules of play, the challenges of the Event and the condition of any property, facilities or equipment used. I also understand that there may be risks involved which are not known to me or to the Distributors, sponsors, organizers, Event Host Cities and other volunteers, and may not be foreseen or reasonably foreseeable by any of them or us at this time or at the time of the Event. I assume all the foregoing risks including the risk of any negligence by other participants or by the Event Host Cities and the Distributors, organizers, sponsors or volunteers of the Event and their respective owners, directors, officers, employees or agents, and the risk of injury caused by the condition of any property, facilities or equipment used during the Event, and accept personal responsibility for any injury (including, but not limited to; personal injury, disability, dismemberment and death), illness, damage, loss, claim, liability or expense, of any kind or nature, that I or my property may suffer arising out of or in connection with the Event or my participation therein or attendance thereof.

Liability Release and Indemnity Agreement: I hereby release and forever discharge and agree to save and hold harmless SSG and its respective parents and their subsidiaries, subsidiaries of its parents and their affiliates, the Event Host Cities and other volunteers associated or affiliated with the Event, the owners, lessor, and lessees of the property, facilities and equipment used in connection with the Event, including without limitation the respective organizers, directors, officers, employees and agents of all of them, and the other participants in the Event (each such entity or individual being referred to as a "Released Party") of and from any and all injuries (including attorneys' fees) of any kind or nature (and whether accruing to me, my heirs or my personal representatives) that are caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by my action, negligence, fault, omission, failure to act, or by my breach or alleged breach of this Waiver and Release, or by the condition of the property, facilities or equipment of any Released Party or that arise out of or in connection with the Event or my participation therein or attendance thereof.

Medical Treatment: In connection with any injury I may sustain or other medical conditions I may experience during my participation in or attendance at the Event, I authorize any emergency first aid, medication, medical treatment or surgery deemed necessary by the attending medical personnel if I am not able to act on my own behalf. I further authorize the attending medical personnel to execute on my behalf any permission forms, consents or other appropriate documents relating to medical attention and to act on my behalf if I am not able of immediately available to do so.

Severability of Provisions: I agree that the foregoing agreements are intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by law. Any provisions herein found by a court to be void or unenforceable shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provisions.
