

**2022 Sunflower State Games Boxing**

**FACT SHEET**

**Registration:**

- Registration is online at USA Boxing and is open until July 1st. Log in using your USA Boxing member number and search the Sunflower State Games on July 9<sup>th</sup> in Topeka, KS to register and be considered for matching.
- There is a \$25 boxer registration fee, which includes a \$5 non-refundable processing fee. If you are not matched \$20 of your registration fee will be returned.
- All boxers must register. Please contact Christina Carlos-Moke @ 913-744-8879 for assistance.
- Registration is open to all boxers who are registered with USA Boxing, regardless of state of residence.
- All boxers must be registered with USA Boxing for 2022 and present a copy of their birth certificate (or have it uploaded to USAB) and an annual physical (or have it uploaded to USAB.)
- All bouts will be matched bouts according to USA Boxing Appendix F.

**Schedule- ALL BOXERS AND COACHES MUST CHECK-IN SATURDAY, JULY 9TH.**

- **9-10 AM, CHECK-IN & WEIGH INS:** Boxers and coaches must present current registration with USA Boxing including passbook with photo at check-in. Boxers must have annual physical in their passbook or uploaded to USA Boxing.
- **10-11 AM: PHYSICALS**
- **1 PM: COMPETITION BEGINS**

**Venue:**

- Stormont Vail Event Center, 1 Expo Drive, Topeka, KS 66612.
- And admission fee will be charged to all spectators. Adults (18 & over)- \$5, Students (5-17) - \$3, Children (4 & under) – Free
- Please note that outside food and drink are not allowed inside the Stormont Vail Event Center. Concessions will be sold on site.

**Boxer Notes**

- Gloves will be provided at the gloving table. All headgear must be USA boxing approved.
- Boxers with long hair must wear a cap or hair net under their headgear. Hair must not extend beyond the neckline.
- Professional boxers and other individuals who have competed as professionals in any combat sports are prohibited from competing in Olympic style boxing.

**USA Boxing JO'S and Summer Festival in Wichita**

Boxers competing at the USA Boxing JO's in Wichita who are also boxing on Saturday at the Sunflower State Games will be allowed to arrive and check-in late to the JO's. Please send boxer name and registration number to Mike Campbell. The boxer/coach should monitor the draw, to be conducted on Sunday in Wichita, via the livestream, to ensure that the boxer is entered and correctly classified.
